STEP 1

Enter your school email and FASTalk password on www.fastalk.org.

Then, click LOG IN to access your FASTalk teacher account.



STEP 2

On your Dashboard, click INBOX to access your conversations.



STEP 3

Your entire class roster will display under STUDENT.

Click on the name of the student whose caregiver(s) you want to message.

Click on the name of the caregiver(s) you want to message. A blue checkmark will appear and your conversation history will display under CHAT-CONVERSATION.



STEP 5

Type your note in the CHAT-CONVERSATION box that says '*Write your message here.*' Click the paper airplane or hit ENTER to send your message.

If you send a message to multiple caregivers, know that each caregiver will receive that message in an individual SMS text so that any response(s) is visible solely to you.
